## **Connect with Leaders**

- 1. Meet interesting people and build lifelong friendships with fellow Trustees from around Florida and Washington, D.C.
- 2. Build pride in being a Floridian by being a champion of America's Only State Embassy in our Nation's Capital.
- 3. Connect with elected and business leaders in both Florida and Washington, D.C. through Florida House Trustee meetings, fundraisers, and other events.
- 4. Explore new facets of Washington, D.C. through unique experiences including behind-the-scenes tours of the U.S. Supreme Court, events with Ambassadors at Embassy's typically not open to the public, receiving briefings on cutting-edge technology from the NASA Administrator Bill Nelson, and talking one-on-one with members of the Florida Congressional Delegation.
- 5. Serve as an ambassador for Florida House within one's own community.

## Celebrate at Florida House

- 1. Trustees who support Florida House at the \$2,500 level are able to host one (1) four-hour event at Florida House for no charge (conditions apply).
  - 1. Trustee can also transfer their one-time House Rental to an outside group who would be charged only \$500 (conditions apply).
- 2. Trustees who support Florida House at the \$500 level (those under 40) are not eligible for this benefit.

## **Champion our Embassy**

- 1. Nominate potential new Trustees (including those under 40) to join Florida House.
- 2. Recommend students to serve as interns at Florida House.
- 3. Nominate Floridians for several awards Florida House bestow: Distinguished Author, Distinguished Artist, 1845 Society, and Rhea Chiles Vision Award.
